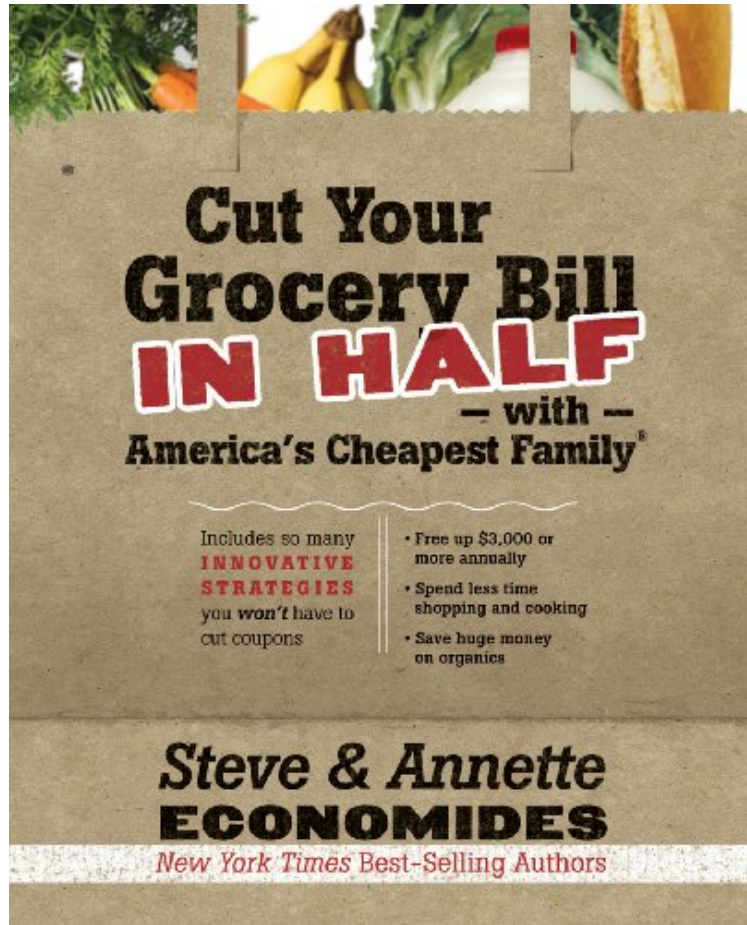

The basic information is solid - use coupons, eat out for less, grow a garden, stock up on items when they are on sale, etc But I'd also bought the book for the recipes and meal suggestions. That was a mistake. If you're comfortable throwing canned or dried soup mixes into most of your recipes then you might want to test some of those in this book. Cream of mushroom soup appears frequently in

everything from Nacho Chicken to Ground Beef Hash to Pork Chops and Rice. The pork chop recipe actually has 3 soups in it -cream of chicken, cream of mushroom, and dried onion soup mix! That's over the top for me- and my family. There are also only 16 recipes in the book, another disappointment. I did appreciate some of the information on using coupons. I thought I'd learned most ways to take advantage of coupons but this book revealed other ideas I'd missed. They even remind readers to use Internet coupons. I needed that reminder. And it was a relief to know they didn't want to be extreme couponers..So there were some nuggets of info in this book. But - at least from my perspective - there just wasn't enough new information. And while I agree with the authors' stance on the value of family dinner time, the section on making dinner fun and tips for family activities seemed odd in a book focused on saving money.
