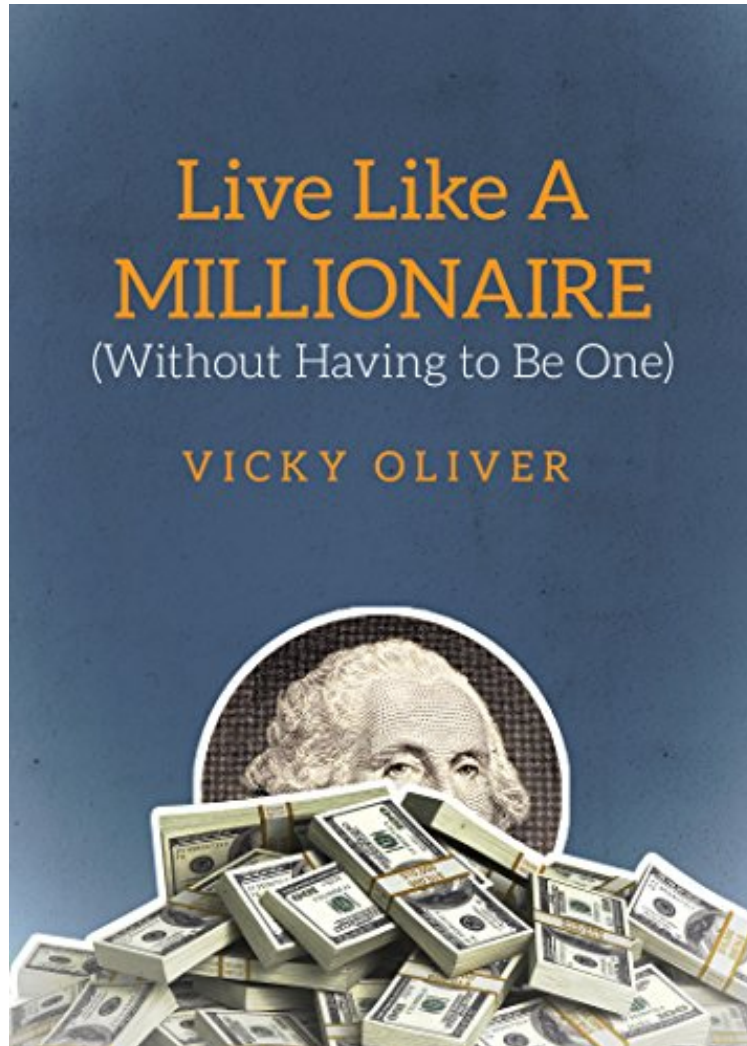

Depending on a given reader's age and experience, some of the advice may seem like common sense; for example, read the New York Times or the Wall Street Journal, including the business sections, so that in casual conversation you will be well-informed rather than ignorant. That's obvious to some people, but not to every twenty-something who is just starting out. Many other chapters involve topics that are certainly not intuitively obvious to an average person. The chapters about dressing for success on frugal budget are particularly valuable. For instance: 80% of the impression

conveyed by your attire is from the clothing above the waist, so allocate a limited clothing budget accordingly. Shoes should be very high quality, but there are many accessories for which you should just buy the cheapest thing available. The book's flavor is white-collar New York City, with some occasional discussion of how things may be different elsewhere.
