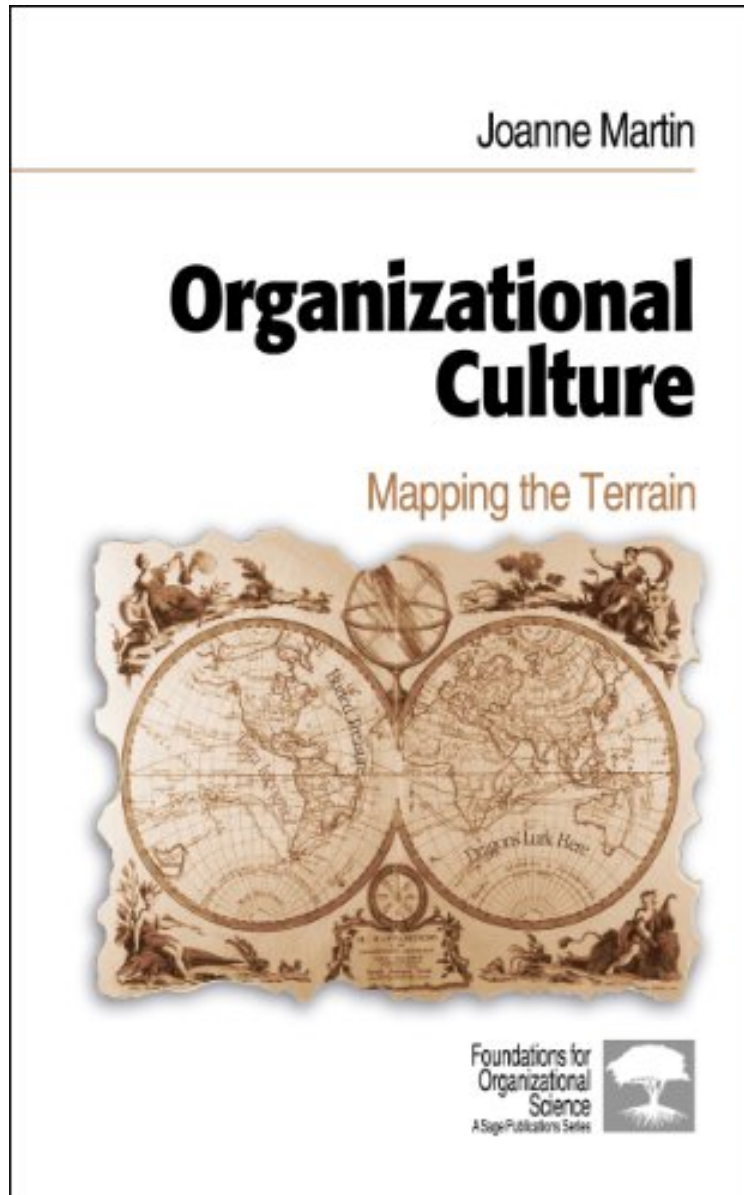


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# Organizational Culture: Mapping the Terrain (Foundations for Organizational Science)
